# MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS SUMMARY

The Village of Duchess has initiated the preparation of its first Municipal Development Plan (MDP). Pursuant to section 632 of the *Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26*, an MDP is a statutory planning document that is adopted as a bylaw by the municipality and is one of the tools a community can use to manage growth and future development.

The Municipal Development Plan will outline the goals and objectives that a municipality has for future development and creates policies that will aid in achieving them. An important component in the MDP preparation process is soliciting public input from the citizens of the municipality.

As a method of determining citizens' concerns and opinions, the Village of Duchess chose to deliver individual questionnaires to each household during the month of June, 2020. The questionnaires were returned to the Village of Duchess by July 15, 2020. The questionnaire was designed to provide Village Council information concerning the direction Duchess should pursue in the future.

A total of 358 questionnaires were circulated throughout the community, 13 were returned due to incorrect addressing on file. Of the 345 questionnaires delivered, 48 surveys were completed and returned to the Village office representing a 14 percent response rate. This document is a summary of the results of the completed questionnaires received by the Oldman River Regional Services Commission. The questionnaires were analyzed and a statistical breakdown with commonalities and recurring themes are summarized below.

#### **Highlights from the Questionnaire**

- Approximately 58.0 percent of the respondents were male and 42.0 percent were female.
- Approximately 58.9 percent of respondents were from the 50-69 age group.
- Approximately 45.8 percent of respondents have lived in Duchess for 15 years or less.
- Major Likes:
  - Small/quiet/safe town
  - o Community spirit and atmosphere
  - Quality of facilities
- Major Dislikes:
  - Lack of bylaw enforcement and police presence
  - Needs more commercial activity
  - Road and infrastructure maintenance
  - Derelict buildings and private properties

- What attracts people to Duchess:
  - o Lifestyle
  - Low crime rate
  - Family
  - Large lots
- Types of facilities needed in the community:
  - o Recreation facilities (i.e. walking paths, community pool)
  - Restaurants/cafes
  - Seniors housing
- Future economic growth of Duchess:
  - Grow slowly
  - o All future growth occur within current village limits
  - o More commercial, recreational and residential development
- The following services meet and/or surpass community expectations:
  - o Curbside Garbage Collection
  - o Recreation Centre
  - o Rescue Services
  - Village Administration

#### 1. What do you like most about Duchess or do not want to see changed?

After reviewing the responses, the citizens of Duchess have determined the following characteristics to be the most notable aspects of their community:

- Quiet, clean and safe
- Community spirit
- Quality of facilities and services
- Small population

This would suggest that Duchess is a family-orientated community with many cultural and community characteristics, which makes Duchess very attractive to its residents.

- Well maintained, quiet, safe. Good infrastructure.
- That it is a small community, not overcrowded!
- Friendly people; but growing fast.
- The quiet prairie, how calm this little village is. Please don't commercialize it. It's quiet and peaceful here. Some drivers here at night get carried away with speed?
- Great, safe place to raise a family. Great schools. Nice people. Great parcels.
- Quiet and affordable.
- Peace and quiet.
- Do not want to see street lights.
- The facilities in the Village are great. I like the way the Village functions as is.
- The residential population. We don't need to aspire to be a 'big' town. Brooks is close enough for that.
- Excellent community to call home best place in the County. Public works does an amazing job to keep the town maintained from snow removal to mowing, fixing potholes to Canada Day flags. I'm so impressed with the effort put in. Well done!
- I like the size of the community but I know that growth is needed for it to be sustainable. Sound policy is needed for appropriate planned growth.
- How fast services are complete, i.e. snow removal, garbage pickup, general maintenance.
- Family oriented safe community. Good management and support staff summer and winter.
- Very friendly atmosphere!!
- The size of this Village and the low crime rate.
- The streets are kept nice. Pavement is good. They spray the parks and school grounds for weeds. It's kept up nicely.
- Flower boxes around town are always well maintained, like that walking path gets cleared in winter, streets are cleared often in winter, and Rec Centre is amazing.
- The quiet small town feel low crime rate.
- The quietness.
- Small community; rec centre; helpful village employees going above and beyond helping out village residents.
- Our town is very clean and quiet. The streets in the winter time are always cleared of snow. Great town for raising a family and retirement.
- Space, green-space, no multi-level buildings, i.e. 2 storey limit.
- I like the size of our village, me and my wife wouldn't want to see it expand too much.
- Quiet and clean.

- We like the small town atmosphere, the recreational facilities and that we have a K-12 school. We also appreciate that we have a clean, well-kept community.
- Quiet and friendly people. Town staff is awesome.
- Beautiful people, kids and adults, people that stop and chat. Many different paths for daily walks. My garden. The birds in the bird feeders in the trees.
- The peace and quiet, originality of the community, safe and low crime rates.
- Quiet for the most part.
- It's quiet and peaceful.
- We enjoy the small-community atmosphere, the proximity to open land and the distance from Brooks.
- Like the small town atmosphere.
- Small town atmosphere people are mostly very neighbourly.
- Quiet and peaceful village.
- The hands on the way the village is operating.
- Keep the school, rec centre, pharmacy, bank, store.
- It's clean.
- Walking paths. Need more.
- Love the parks for children, the way street maintenance is maintained cleaned, snow removal, parks mowed, general appearance of Village very appealing.
- Small village, quiet, community united.
- Amount of facilities available for use.
- I like the community spirit. It's great to see neighbours coming together. I feel my kids are safe and people look out for each other.
- Small town atmosphere. Like the back alley pickup.

#### 2. What do you like least about Duchess or feel needs to be changed?

Following is a list of issues and concerns that respondents have with the community:

- Bylaw enforcement and lack of police presence
- Needs more commercial services
- Road and infrastructure maintenance
- Derelict buildings and private properties

- Needs archery range.
- I would like an engine retarder ban. They cut the tree bottoms and vehicle noise is very loud (would be nice to have a sound fence from stop sign to car wash).
- The wind, sometimes it's just too much. The Hotel and Chinese restaurant look so very down.
- Drainage system.
- Road repairs.
- No control of recreational vehicles (motorcycles, ATV, snowmobiles) south of town. No control of weeds. Lack of consistent vacant lot mowing (do it right). Always the poorest solution to resolve issues. CHEAP!
- Railway Ave. is super noisy! Trucks, racing cars, bikes etc. Would like to see this patrolled more. Especially after hours! Also, would like carwash to follow after-hours noise bylaw and close their doors.

- Bulldoze that big dirt pile in the southeast part, in that big open area. It's an eyesore. Get
  pressure on the owners of vacant properties to keep their grass/weeds under control, or
  charge \$250 to clean it up for them.
- I like that the town has a family atmosphere. I would not want to see developments that would attract more transient, unstable groups (apartments, town houses, trailer parks). I would also like to see the back alleys improved/cleaned up. Trimming trees back to property lines would be appreciated.
- I'd like to see another access into the village from Hwy 873 at the southern border with the County.
- Nothing. Duchess is amazing.
- Taxes are too high you have a brand new office. Stop the high end expenditures and let's concentrate on roads and lowering taxes.
- Duchess needs some seniors housing!!
- There is nothing I don't like.
- Some back yard are pretty sad. Vehicles or campers not off the back allies. There are a lot of cats all over Town. People turn out at night using for yard for a litter box.
- More garbage cans, more trees in park, sidewalk all along centre street all the way. Stray/free

The data indicates that a slight majority of the respondents want residential development in the community to grow slowly. However, the chart also indicates that a sizeable percentage of the community wants to see the community to continue growing at a moderate rate.

While the majority stated that they have access, respondents indicated that while there is access to the internet, it is quite costly for the quality (see comments below).

#### Comments:

- Could be better as it is slightly slow and freezes often.
- I don't consider 15 MBPs and 0.6 MBPs download to be 'high speed'. We need TELUS to include Duchess in its fibre roll-out. TELUS has stated that towns wish to get their optic fibre network need to get vocal about getting onto and then moving up their priority list.
- No we are not happy with it.
- Could be better.
- EID very happy.
- Not happy.
- Have access but service is slow by todays standard.
- EID is awesome.
- Yes have access, not happy with level of service.
- Yes but not happy with the service.
- Yes have access, not happy with level of service.
- Yes I have access, I am not happy with the level of service.

A small majority of respondents are not willing to pay a local improvement tax to cover costs of improving access to high speed internet. Those who were willing to pay indicated that it would be dependent on the cost of such a tax (see comments below).

- We don't need more wireless towers, we need a fibre optic cable!! I don't believe we need
  to pay more. I pay \$90/mo. for TELUS 'high speed'. For that price in Calgary I'd be getting 300
  MBPs upload and download speeds! What we need to do is pressure TELUS to expand their
  fibre network along the Trans-Canada, then the mere 15 km north to us. Asking the provincial
  government to get involved might also help.
- You are already skimming with the municipal franchise fees on gas and power!! Fix the potholes.
- Maybe how much?
- Needed to attract businesses.
- If cost is reasonable.
- 1000%.

- I would love to see a few more essential businesses in Duchess which are needed; however, I fear that if it becomes too commercial, the quiet nature of this little village will only be like the rest of the noisy towns and cities.
- Heavy rain always an issue. Young family. Not having a preschool would be a huge loss. Can't believe they would raise rent on the only thing that will rent the hall.
- Street lights on Lousie. Upgrade old sidewalks and put sidewalks on both sides of the street. Fix walkway by post office. Sidewalk is on the opposite side of crossing.
- I feel the bylaw officers hanging out trying to catch people could use their time better. They could patrol the Duchess Drag Strip at night for instance.
- Completing the north circuit of the paved path (around the golf course, then connecting it to NW end of town) would be nice. I've heard rumours about a possible retirement community at east end of Emerson Ave / south of Thom's. I know that many retirees would rather live here than in Brooks, i.e. those from here. What's the status on that? Has it even been officially proposed? Thankfully, incidents of noisy, speeding dirt bikers and quadders is rare, but is there a peace officer who actually lives in and patrols the Village? Whom we could phone instead of the RCMP, when there is a problem?

Activities like Golf Course, Recreation Centre, and Hockey Arena etc. Duchess has a post office, wash bays, liquor store, a new very good Pharmacy, Fire department, garages. Administration is approachable. I can't think of more what might be needed. Everything else what might be missing... Brooks is 15-20 mins away.
